TEENS Digital TCG Tuesdays **Tuesdays, Nov. 2, 9, 16, 23, 30** **5:00pm-8:00pm**

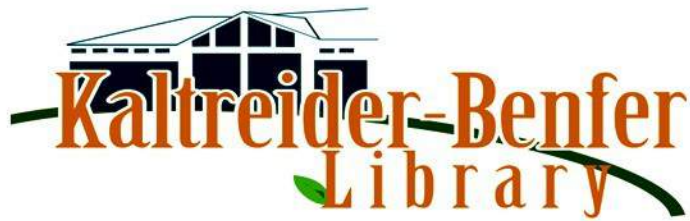
