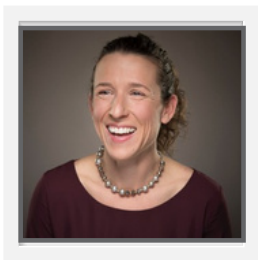

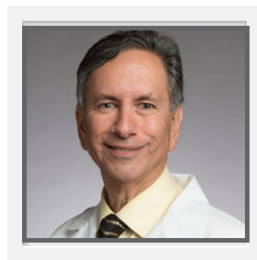
- Learn about the health effects of tobacco and vaping and its impact on our youth.

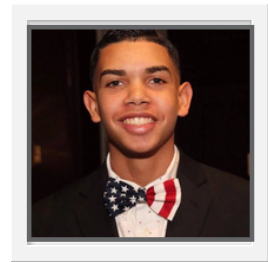
