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# Conrad's Youth Baseball Parent/Player Code of Conduct

Having fun...it's what being a kid is all about!

Youth athletes do not play baseball to train for a career in professional sports. Children play baseball to have fun and make friends! Sometimes parents, coaches, spectators, and players themselves don't realize that their actions, whether verbal or non-verbal, have long-lasting emotional effects on children.

- 1. I will NOT force my child/myself to participate in sports.
- 2. I will remember that we participate to have fun and that the game is being played for the children and not the adults.
- 3. I will be a positive role model for my child/peers.
- 4. I will encourage good sportsmanship by always showing respect and courtesy.
- 5. I will NOT engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike behaviors. Taunting, profane language, booing, and refusing to shake hands will NOT be tolerated.
- 6. I will NOT encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health or well-being of the athletes.
- 7. I will teach my child, peers, and players to play by the rules and resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility of violence.
- 8. I will demand that my child, peers, and players treat other players, coaches, officials, and spectators with the utmost respect.
- 9. I will teach my child, peers, and players that doing one's best is more important that winning, so that my child, peers, and players will never feel defeated by the outcome of the game or his/her performance.
- 10. I will praise my child, peers, and players for competing fairly by trying hard and make them feel like a winner every time.
- 11. I will never ridicule or yell at my child, peers, players, or other participants for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- 12. I will emphasize skill development and practice, instead of winning.
- 13. I will de-emphasize competition for children in lower levels.
- 14. I will respect game officials and their authority.
- 15. I will NOT confront coaches on the game field, but instead meet with them and Conrad's Staff at an agreed upon time.
- 16. I will demand a sports environment for my child, peers, and players that is free from drugs, alcohol, and tobacco. I will refrain from use at all events.
- 17. I will refrain from couching my child, peers, and players during the games, unless I am one of the official team coaches.
- 18. I will refrain from any type of bullying.

The individual who signs the Code of Conduct is responsible for ensuring that it is being followed by ALL invited spectators.
